PALESTINE VILLAGE SPECIAL BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING AND PUBLIC HEARING

July 14, 2011

The Palestine Board of Trustees met on July 14, 2011, at 6:00 PM. Trustees answering the roll call were Gene Purcell, Greta Dennison, Larry Miller, and Larry Surrells. J.D. Kimberlin and J.R. Dunlap were absent.

Visitors present: Linda Trueblood and Jim L. Martin.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Schofield.

The meeting began with all present reciting the Pledge of Allegiance

A Special Public Hearing was held in regard to the annexation of the Jim L. Martin property described as: Ten (10) feet evenly off of the North side of five acres, more or less, in the Northeast corner of a certain tract of land, containing 50 acres, described as follows, to-wit: The West side of the North part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 2, in Township 6 North of Range 11 West, said five acres, more or less, being bounded on the South and West by the present line of Lamotte Creek and on the North and East by the lands of J.L. Leaverton.

Mayor Schofield opened the meeting to questions concerning the proposed annexation agreement. Linda Trueblood asked if the annexation would affect her property in any way as she was concerned about her taxes. She was assured it would not, as we are only annexing the above described property.

With no further questions, the Annexation Agreement was then executed by Jim L. Martin and the Village of Palestine.

Larry Surrells moved to approve 'An Ordinance to Approve the Annexation Agreement to Annex Certain Property of Jim L. Martin'. Greta Dennison seconded motion. Motion passed.
