AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 41, TRAFFIC, SECTION 41.17 BICYCLES AND MOTORCYCLES, SUBSECTION E OF THE PALESTINE VILLAGE CODE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Palestine, Illinois, has the power and authority to regulate traffic within the Palestine Village limits; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Palestine, Illinois, has determined to amend Chapter 41, Traffic, Section 41.17 BICYCLES AND MOTORCYCLES of Section (e) Riding on Sidewalk Prohibited, such that said Section shall be, in its entirety, as follows:

41.17 BICYCLES AND MOTORCYCLES

(e) Riding on Sidewalk Prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle or scooter on the sidewalks adjacent to Main Street from Franklin Street to LaMotte Street.

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor than \$750.00 and the costs of prosecution.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
