ORDINANCE NO. 2018-0- 12
AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE TO THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND
THE VILLAGE CLERK TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, from time to time, it has become necessary, in instances where the Village Board has approved expenditures of funds, and with regard to other documents, that signatures of the Village President and the Village Clerk are required on such documents; and

WHEREAS, it is impractical, from time to time, to provide documentation that the Village President and the Village Clerk were authorized to execute such documents; and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be in the best interest of the Village of Palestine, that the Village President and the Village Clerk be authorized to execute such documents as shall be necessary to carry out the actions of the Board of Trustees of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Palestine, Crawford County, Illinois, that on documents approved by the Board of Trustees, requiring an authorized signatory thereto, that the Village President and the Village Clerk be, and that they are hereby authorized to execute and deliver such documents on behalf of the Village of Palestine, Illinois.


BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
