AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF PALESTINE CRAWFORD COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Henderson, Registered Illinois Land Surveyor No. 2101, dated June 20, 1986. as corrected June 30, 1986, and recorded in Cabinet C, Slide 428 in the Office of the Recorder of Crawford County, Illinois.
